Canine Support Teams' "Pawz for Wounded Veterans Program," provides service and assistance dogs to those who have sustained disabling injuries or suffer from PTSD as a result of military service. When wounded soldiers go through rehabilitation therapy, they are surrounded by men and women who have shared their experiences in battle. But when they return home, they leave this support system behind, and some may struggle to make the transition back to civilian life. Canine Support Teams provides service dogs to enhance mobility and independence while offering unconditional love, and companionship. Not only does a service dog provide assistance with daily activities, the dog serves as a bridge. People focus on the dog, not the disability. This leads to conversation and acceptance.
