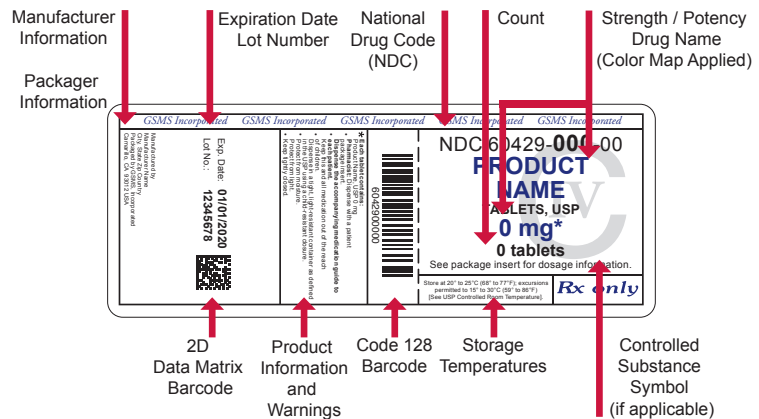
ColorMap
